

TRAINING SUPPORT - TWO EACH

BS/BA degree and 4-6 years of training related work experience; OR an AA degree and 6-8 years of experience in specific area of training being presented; OR a HS Diploma with 8-10 years of specific experience consistent with the material being presented. Training Specialists need the depth and breadth of knowledge and skills of an Associate Training Specialist: In order to develop training materials, anticipate potential student difficulties, draw analogies, and answer questions from people with many different backgrounds, this position requires substantial expertise in the field being presented. Knowledge of the content of assigned lessons sufficient to evaluate the relative importance of concepts, generalizations of concepts, and application to various jobs onsite is required in order to pinpoint causes of deficiencies in achievement. Familiarity with applicable Federal Laws, DOE order, and company policies is also required. In addition, they must be able to demonstrate exemplary performance to tasks in the discipline and evaluate student performance of those tasks.
